

Preschool Information

Preschool information for 4-year olds:

- Charlie Brown Preschool for four-year olds is an official satellite classroom for Mason City Public Schools and Clear Lake Public Schools; Voluntary Preschool Program.
- Voluntary Preschool at Charlie Brown is free.
- Classes are Monday through Friday from 9:00am-11:30am OR 12:30pm-3pm. Class times vary depending on the center and number of children enrolled each year.
- Teachers are required to have a BA in Early Childhood Education.
- Children can be enrolled any time before October 1st.
- Class size is limited to 20 per class.
- Children who are or will be 4 years old by September 15th will be accepted on a first come basis.
- Each preschool student must have a birth certificate.

Preschool information for 3-year olds:

- Tuition is \$265.00 per month.
- Preschool is M-F 8:30-12:30 and includes breakfast and lunch.
- Qualified teachers on staff.
- Preschool curriculum is "Creative Curriculum."
- Children attending the centers for child care receive preschool at no extra cost.

Dear Families,

We would like to welcome you to our Preschool Program. Our Program is from 8:30am-12:30pm including breakfast and lunch, Monday through Friday. Instructional time is from 9:00am-11:00am Charlie Brown Centers have Preschool rooms: ages 2-3 years, 3-4 years, & 4-5 years. The child's room placement is determined by the child' birth date of September 15th.

Each room has experienced teachers with degrees, years of experience, and training. Each staff is certified in First Aid, Infant, Child, & Adult CPR, and Universal Precautions.

Our Preschool curriculum is a play based and creative curriculum of learning. Play helps a child learn about her/himself and what she/he can do; learn about others; and learn about her/his environment. Play helps to establish friendships and helps to express feelings. We incorporate Creative Curriculum from Quality Preschools Standards Training for our curriculum. Each week (sometimes more) we center around one main study with activities that teach the seven domains of learning: language & literacy, mathematical thinking, scientific thinking, social skills, the arts, and small & large motor skills.

Each month we send home a brief newsletter and calendar describing what your child will be learning and any additional information you will need to know for that month. We offer conferences twice per year so that you can be informed about your child's development. We will also be collecting projects throughout the year for a portfolio to show your child's growth.

In order to enhance each individual child's development, a variety of experiences are planned. We have several special events throughout the year such as celebration parties, seasonal musical performances, Grandparent's day, spring play, science fair, and graduation. Field trips are planned through out the year as well as community member presentations.

Our Preschool program has an open-door policy and we encourage you to visit as much as you wish. We believe that the key to developing a program for young children is frequent communication between parents and center to benefit us all.

We believe that a quality program for young children should promote and maintain growth in self worth of each child. It is our goal to help the children in our care to become caring human beings.
